

**Date** Date of Inspection

**Q** Presence of Queen  
(P Queen seen, X Queen not found  
C Queen clipped)  
W,Y,R,G,B Queen marked with  
appropriate colour code.

**QC** Presence of Queen Cells  
(x=none. 10x=10 seen but all removed.  
2L=2 seen and left alone.

**Brood** State of Brood  
(e=eggs seen. P=brood pattern OK.  
3=brood covering 3 frames.  
x=no brood)

**Stores** The quantity of stores available.  
(10= equivalent of 10 super frames  
available)

**Room** The available space for the Queen  
to lay eggs.  
(5=equivalent of 5 brood frames  
available)

**Health** The state of the brood and adult bees.  
(P=all is ok. CB?=possible chalk brood.  
EFB?=possible EFB etc)

**Varroa** The number of Varroa mites in  
the colony  
(L,M,H= Low, Medium and High.  
1000=estimated population)

**Temper** The docility of the colony.  
(10=nice calm bees, 8=agitated  
6=bees stings etc)

**Feed** How much feed given.  
(2LS= 2 Litres of light syrup  
1HS= 1 Litre of Heavy syrup  
F= Fondant)

**Supers** How many supers removed  
or added.  
(1=one super added.  
-0.5 frames removed etc)

**Weather** The temperature and cloud cover.  
(c=cloudy. s=sunny. r=rainy  
f=fair)

**Notes** Anything of interest to add  
(lots of propolis, brood box  
needs repairs/replaced etc)

If you are not sure whether a disease is  
present, it is advised that you consult a more  
experienced beekeeper.

If you think EFB or AFB may be present it is  
mandatory that you contact an appointed  
bee inspector.
